

#### Fill-A-Backpack



Millions of people worldwide struggle to meet their basic needs every day. Lack of access to clean water, food, and shelter creates a cycle of poverty that is difficult to break. ## Pakistan Floods Rehabilitation

In 2022, catastrophic floods in Pakistan left 33 million people affected by the loss of life, injury, displacement and destruction of homes.

More than 1,700 people lost their lives, 12,867 were injured, and as many as 879,000 homes were destroyed,

leaving 2.1 million men, women, and children in horrific conditions.

The elderly stayed awake at night to ensure children did not fall into the water and drown as they slept. During the day, women took turns keeping flies off the children as they swarmed their sleeping faces. In 2022, catastrophic floods in Pakistan left 33 million people affected by the loss of life, injury, displacement and destruction of homes.



To address the urgent need for assistance, MWC quickly took action to provide the affected people with food, shelter and 900 water purification kits with the help of our partners.

As the flood water recedes, survivors of these grave conditions will continue to need our help.

At MWC, we're committed to helping survivors rebuild their homes after this tragedy with resilient structures capable of withstanding future disasters.

Through MWC's Pakistan Rehabilitation program, families in need are offered a safe haven and the hope of rebuilding their lives, starting with a roof over their heads.

## Long-Term Care

A better future for seniors in need.



As the senior population in Ontario is set to almost double by 2041, estimated to reach 4.6 million, the need for more accessible and affordable long-term care homes grows.

Muslim Welfare Canada has heard this call to action, striving towards creating a Campus of Care that not just meets but exceeds expectations.


The first phase, a 192-bed long-term care home, will provide invaluable support and comfort while addressing disparities within our aging communities - no one should be denied quality care due to their background or ethnicity. The facility will provide care for those who need full-time assistance and include an on-site pharmacy and physiotherapy clinic.

The second phase, a 96-unit apartment complex will offer affordable housing

for seniors who live independently. These facilities will allow seniors to age in place and maintain their independence for as long as possible.
