MWC Food

At MWC, tackling food insecurity is at the core of our mission. We're dedicated to eradicating hunger across Canada and globally, striving to be at the forefront of support for both young and old whenever the need arises.

Food Bank

Scarborough & Mississauga.

Food banks help assist more than 850,000+ Canadians every month. Each food bank supplies beneficiaries with perishable and non-perishable food, household items, clothing, footwear and winter gear.

It costs \$50+ to sponsor a visit to the food bank.

This year alone, we had over 30,000+ visits to our food banks.





Arctic Food Bank

Inuvik, NT & Iqaluit, NU.

Regent Meals

Regent Park, Toronto.

This program serves over 700+ meals every Saturday & Sunday at the Fred Victor in downtown Toronto. It costs only \$6 to sponsor a meal.

We have served over to 117,000+ meals to the Regent Park community.

Project Ramadan

Ottawa.

To fundraise, assemble, and distribute baskets containing staple food items during the Holy month of Ramadan.

Donate a food basket for \$70.

We built and distributed over 100,000+ food baskets across Ontario since 2009.





Qurbani & ★ Zabiha

We have prepared and provided Qurbani meat to many parts of the world, including Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Syria, India, Yemen, Somalia, Palestine, the Rohingya refugee camps and Azad Kashmir.

In 2023 alone, over \$300,000+ of meat was distributed locally and globally.

Meals on Wheels

Toronto & Hamilton.

We prepare over 500 lunch bags, and warm clothes, blankets and sleeping bags are distributed to assist the homeless in coping with the harsh weather.

It costs only \$3 to sponsor a lunch.

To date, we have distributed over 373,000+ meals to the most vulnerable.



Malvern Eats

Marlvern Tavern, Toronto.

Every Wednesday, we come together to provide residents with freshly prepared lunches.

It costs only \$6 to sponsor a meal.

Since its launch, we have served over 117,000+ meals to the Malvern community.



Meals on Wheels for Seniors

Toronto & Mississauga.

Since 2013, we prepare and provide 500 low-income seniors with healthy meals delivered right to their doorsteps, twice a week with regular check-ins. It costs only \$11 to sponsor a meal.

To date, we have distributed over 190,000+ meals delivered to eldery.

MWC Wellness

We uphold the belief that access to healthcare is a fundamental right for everyone. We offer services to those lacking insurance, aiming to promote health equity across all communities.

Free Medical Clinic

Toronto & Mississauga.

Our usual patients are refugees, new immigrants, international students, and visitors.

We offer highly personalized healthcare and have helped over 600 patients without OHIP coverage remotely this year.

9,600+ patients served since 2009.





Al Abbas Mussallah and Food Bank

Mississauga.

Is a space dedicated to educational and spiritual growth for the community in our Mississauga facility that provides couselling services, and also houses our Halal Food and Essential Items Bank.

About 200 people per week attend the Mussallah for Friday Prayers.

Mother & ★ Child Support

Pakistan.

To address the grave nutritional needs and health concerns of pregnant women, young mothers, and their children in Pakistan's drought-stricken Tharparkar desert region.

We have supported more than 1,000 vulnerable women and their children.



MWC Homes

28% of women-led households in Canada are in core housing need. Approximately 699 women and 236 accompanying children are turned away from domestic violence shelters across Canada each day.

Muslim Welfare Homes

Whitby, Ontario.

MWC operates two programs to offer shelter and safety to women & their children needing a lifeline. We provide safe and dignified living space and nutritious hot meals.

19,500+ women and children assisted since 1996.





Long-Term Care

The facility is set to open in 2026 & will provide care for those who need full-time assistance and include an on-site pharmacy and physiotherapy clinic.

As the senior population in Ontario is set to almost double by 2041, estimated to reach 4.6 million, the need for more accessible and affordable long-term care homes grows.

Muslim Welfare Residences

Whitby, Ontario.

Provides boarding lodging for up to three years to women of all backgrounds facing homelessness . The facility also provides professional life-skills training to enable the residents to become independent.

Case work, mental health, addiction counselling, and other support provided.

Fill-A-Backpack

GTA & Northen Territories.

At MWC, we've taken the initiative to fill school bags for underprivileged children every year.

This year we've travelled to the north to deliver school bags to communities in need.

Since 2014, distributed over 22,000+ backpacks.





Pakistan.

Over 700 students are sponsored annually in our 2 schools in Karachi's less affluent neighbourhoods, with quality education to children in need, school supplies, uniforms, and shoes and help their families with food.

It costs \$1/day to support a child and \$3/day to support a Deaf child.

Public School Nutrition

GTA.

Our efforts have allowed us to extend our breakfast, morning meals, and snack programs to include 24 schools across the high need areas of the GTA, including the region of Durham.

Contributed over \$300,000 in support of school nutrition since 2009.



MWC Relief

MWC Relief provides immediate assistance to those in need with 28 years of service based upon the value of serving the needy irrespective of religion, nationality, or ethnicity.

Pakistan Floods Rehabilitation *

Pakistan.

In 2022, the catastrophic floods took 1,700 lives, injured 12,867, and destroyed 879,000 homes, leaving 2.1 million men, women and children in horrific conditions.

MWC provided the affected people with food, shelter and water purification kits with the help of our implementing partners.



We have received support from hundreds of our donors to carry out this project, and each water well or hand pump is commemorated with a plaque bearing the donor's name.


We welcome sponsors interested in this initiative to join us in helping children and families living in remote villages with access to clean drinking water.

The cost of sponsoring a hand pump is \$500, and a well is \$1,500.

Over 3,250 wells and hand pumps have been installed in desert regions across Pakistan since the start of the project in 2005.


